Part B. CV SUMMARY

Josefa Ros, PhD with **European Mention** in Philosophy (Complutense University of Madrid, 2017, **FPU12/01877-MECD**, €64,820, **PhD Extraordinary Prize**), **Spanish National Research Prize 2022**, is the leading expert in Boredom Studies in Spain and one of the most internationally recognized for her pioneering research in this field of knowledge. For more than a decade, she has analyzed the experience of dysfunctional boredom from a multidisciplinary point of view, in which philosophical, psychological, and sociological theoretical-practical perspectives converge, with emphasis on older adults living institutionalized, applying the Philosophy of Care principles. She has been the first person in Spain to open this research line and to place at the center of scientific and social dialogue the hypothesis that dysfunctional boredom is a risk factor that endangers the physical and mental well-being of older adults. Currently, at Complutense, she is **PI** of the **“PRE-BORED”** project (2021-2024, 36 months), funded with €173,168 by the **EU H2020 program** with an **MSCA contract**, to research the causes and consequences of the experience of boredom in nursing homes. Previously (2017-2021, 48 months), she had a **Harvard University Postdoctoral Fellowships for Distinguished Junior Scholars contract** (€105,579.52) to lead as **PI** the **“Psychopathology of Boredom”** project, from which she created her own theoretical framework to distinguish functional and dysfunctional boredom. At **Harvard**, she worked as an **Assistant Professor** (1,448 hrs.). She was also **postdoc Assistant Researcher** (PAII25/21-9/2021-22, €5,341.87) for 3 months at the UCM for the project “Philosophy for the development of Person-Centered Care models (FILACP)” and enjoyed **3 research stays for 9 months** at the **Stuttgart Universität** and the **DLA Marbach**, financed by the **DAAD**, the **DLA Marbach** and the **MECD** (€7,500). The results of her research have been published in **196 works**, including scientific articles, chapters, books, reports, and informative articles (see quality indicators). Her most notable work is *The Disease of Boredom* (Alianza, 2022), which has received 22 citations, 20 reviews and 4 nominations. Her conclusions have been presented at **162 conferences** and communicated to society through the media in **372 interviews**. During this time, Dr. Ros has led **collaborations in Europe, the United States and Latin America**, which have culminated in the **organization of 16 international conferences** and the



publication of 15 collective books with publishers in **Q1**. She is also part of **international projects** such as “Futbol Viral” (**Harvard University**), collaborated with the “Transparency and Technology for Better Health” project (**Harvard Kennedy School**), has established ties with the **JRC ISPRA** of the **European Commission** and has helped open the Spanish branch of the American organization **The Eden Alternative**. In 2021, she created the **first association in the world** for the study of boredom, the **International Society of Boredom Studies** (FICUM Award 2023), which she presides, and the **Journal of Boredom Studies**. On the national scene, Ros has established several **collaboration agreements** with entities in the **private sector**, such as the Santalucía Institute, ALBOR Consulting or Inforesidencias, and the **public sector**, such as the Alicia y Guillermo Foundation, the Colisée Foundation, the Intent HQ Chair of IESE or the D. G. of Care for the Elderly and Dependency of Madrid Government. She also offers **training and consulting services** for nursing homes and foundations such as Intress, APROCOR or ASISPA. In addition, she has collaborated in **21 research projects** funded by the **MICINN**, the **FECYT** or the **BBVA**, in which €760,256.37 in funding have been obtained. Ros has been **teaching at the UCM since 2014** (accredited as a **Contracted Doctor** in 2017; **7 Excellent evaluations**), where she supervises **2 PhD students** and **3 Erasmus+ stays**, works for the Student Observatory and is **PI** of two **projects of innovation** with +50 people in charge. She works as a **project evaluator** for organizations such as MICINN, CONICYT, DAAD, La Caixa Social Observatory, MIAS and The Leverhulme Trust, in addition to being part of **12 scientific and editorial journal committees** and having participated in **15 thesis panels**. Ros’ work was **distinguished**, in addition to the **Spanish National Research Prize** (MICINN, 2022), with other awards such as the Alumni Research-UCM Prize (2021), the DomusVi National Media Prize (2021), the Julián Marías Prize (Madrid Government, 2020) or the Harvard Lincoln Book Prize (2019). In the next step of her career, Ros will address dysfunctional boredom in nursing homes in conjunction with other problems such as loneliness and the feeling of helplessness to propose holistic activities capable of eradicating these three plagues from the lives of dependent older adults and to intervene in public policies on well-being, developing a new ethical paradigm based on Person-Directed Care.
